





# I STILL CAN'T BELIEVE IT!

2021 was a mix of relief, hope, and uncertainty, for us and our 148 residents. A year where we focused on mental health and stability, on increasing our services to residents and on staying connected.

We are so happy to have achieved a 78% COVID vaccination rate among our residents! We are confident that the vaccine lowered COVID-19-related hospitalizations and deaths in our communities while helping to ensure there was no loss of life among our residents.

Another pandemic-related issue was the exacerbation of food deserts in Baltimore as residents were unable to leave their homes to shop and unable to afford food delivery services. We tackled this by partnering with Bmore Community



Foods, a local organization that rescues food and redistributes it to communities that suffer from food insecurity, lack of access, and resources to healthy food. They packaged and provided the food, and our staff picked up the boxes and delivered them to our residents – a service that continues for those in need to this day.

During COVID, we also rolled out the first phase of computer literacy classes, initially for 10 residents. Titled "All Access Technology Training Program, "These classes proactively address the digital divide that the pandemic made so evident. Most of our residents did not have the privilege of having learned computer skills or of being able to afford high-speed internet or computers, which puts them at a great disadvantage when the only way to communicate, access social services, and often work, was through using technology.

We used grant funds to upgrade our buildings to support the addition of high-speed internet access, purchased computers, and hired a qualified instructor. Resident morale grew as they began to learn computer skills, and connected with friends, family, physicians, and more. This saved them money in transportation costs, contributed to their feelings of safety, and increased their confidence and ability.

And for an amazing end-of-year, Berkshire sponsored holiday presents for all the wonderful children in our residences! Moments like these confirm our path, when we see happy children with brighter futures - and all thanks to our staff and supporters!

### TAX CREDITS

The Women's Housing Coalition may have Community Investment Tax Credits for purchase. Any individual or business that pays taxes to the state of Maryland can donate \$500 or more to WHC and earn tax credits equal to 50% of the value of the donation to reduce their tax liability. The tax credits must be used against Maryland state taxes owed for the year in which the contribution was made - they may not be used retroactively for taxes from a prior year. These tax credits are in addition to the deductions on state taxes as a result of the charitable contribution and do not affect your ability to claim a federal charitable deduction. 






# 2021 FINANCIAL POSITION


